Buckinghamshire Record Society Grants

The Buckinghamshire Record Society offers grants in pursuit of the Society's objectives.

Individual grants are available for the production of publications based on original records illustrative of the history of Buckinghamshire (including the whole of the historic county).

Awards may be made towards:

- travel and other research expenses (excluding university fees)
- cost of publication where the material is not appropriate for one of the Society's own volumes
- attendance at conferences within the UK in order to make presentations on Buckinghamshire records
- listing of public and private records relating to the county

Applications can be made for existing projects or ones which have not yet started. Grants are available to postgraduate students and other researchers.

Applicants should submit to the Society, preferably by email:

- A description of their project and how it meets the Society's objectives (maximum 1,000 words).
- The sum applied for (maximum of £2,000 in one application but subsequent applications for the same project will be considered), with a breakdown of what the money is required for and a timetable of the project.
- The applicant's curriculum vitae, including details of any previous research grants received.
- Email and postal addresses of two referees who are willing to be contacted by the Society.
- Details of any other funding for the same project which has been applied for or received.

Applications will be considered at the Society's committee meetings in March and November and should therefore be submitted by 15 February or 15 October in any year for consideration at the following meeting. Applications sent by post rather than email should be submitted by 15 January or 15 September.

Applicants awarded a grant will be required to submit, within one calendar year of their receipt of a grant, a report which may be published on the Society's website setting out how the Society's objectives have been met, and a financial statement of how the grant was spent. They should also provide the Society with a copy of any publication or thesis which was aided by a grant.
